Zangezur Copper-Molybdenum Combine is **the largest mining enterprise in the region** and in Armenia. The company is located in the Syunik region of the Republic of Armenia, on the administrative territory of the cities of Kajaran and Kapan.

ZCMC's average productivity is **22 million tons of ore per year**. The company has plans to expand production to 30 million tonnes in the first stage.

ZCMC is **one of the ten global molybdenum producers**.

The plant produced its first serial products in 1952.

The work history of the plant can be divided into two main periods: 1940-2004. years before privatization and from 2004 to the present post-privatization period.

- In **1966**, the plant was awarded the highest government award of the USSR - the Order of Lenin. During the years of the existence of the USSR, **representatives of 17 nationalities** worked at the plant: Armenians, Russians, Ukrainians, Belarusians, Tatars, etc.
- In **2004**, the plant was privatized, and the German company “Kronimet Mining” became the main shareholder.
- In **2021**, a controlling stake in the company was acquired by the “Industrial Company” group of companies. **21.8% of the company belongs to the Republic of Armenia**.
- **2022** marks the 70th anniversary of the company's activities. Today it is the number 1 taxpayer of the Republic of Armenia and provides employment to more than **4,600 employees** along with its subsidiaries.

According to official data in **2022**, the Zangezur Copper-Molybdenum Combine continued to be considered the largest taxpayer in the republic, paying about **144 billion drams**.

According to official data in **2023**, the first place in the list of 1000 large taxpayers was taken by the Zangezur Copper-Molybdenum Combine, which paid taxes amounting to more than **70 billion drams**.

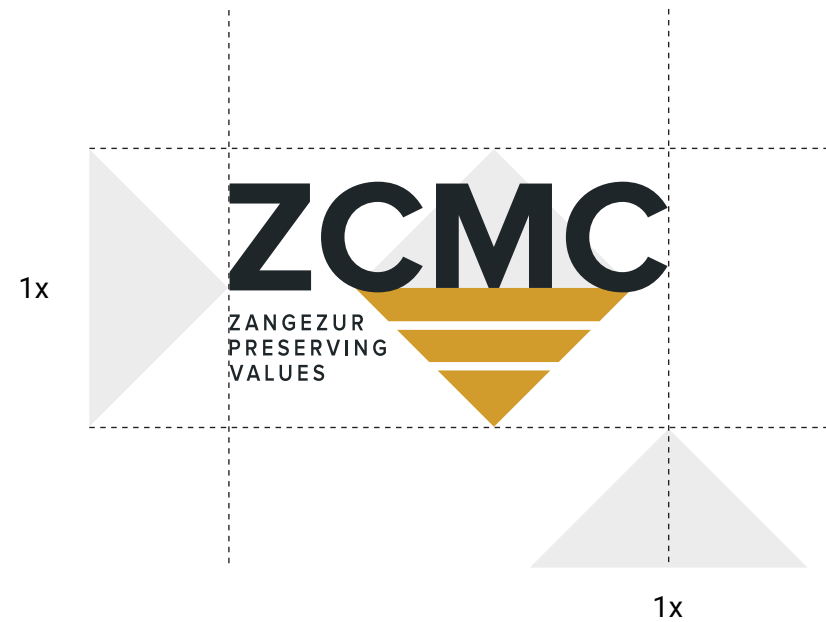

LOGO USAGE

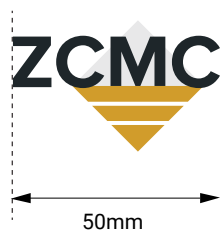




Make sure the logo is always legible and has enough clear space around it to not interfere with other texts, visual elements, or the border of the medium its presented on.

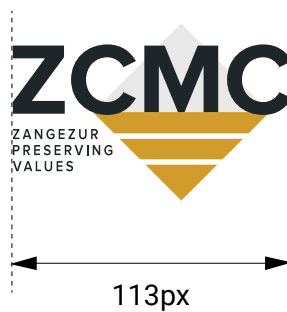
Print Minimum

The ZCMC logo should never be smaller than 50mm in print.



Digital Minimum

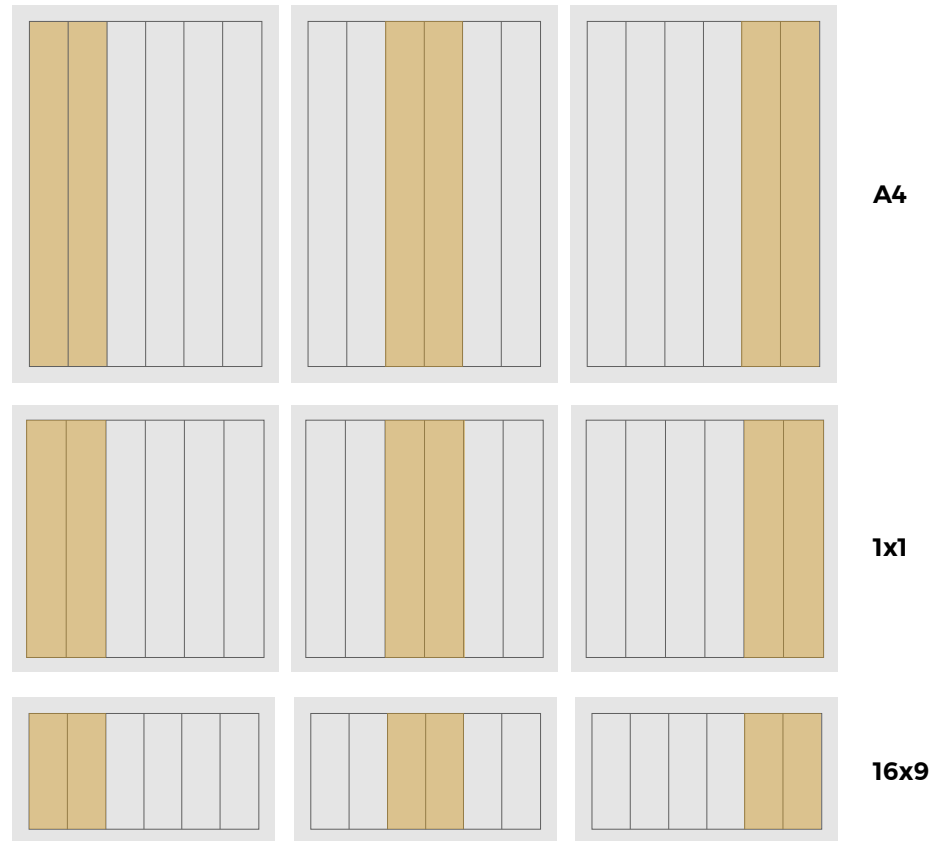
The ZCMC logo should never be smaller than 113px in digital.



Embroidery Minimum

The ZCMC logo should never be smaller than 60mm in embroidery.





The logo should always be placed in the left, center, or right 2/6th of the design. Its size should be appropriate to fit within that section.



Do not distort or alter the proportions of the logo



Do not add contours to the logo



Do not change any elements respective to each other



Do not rotate the logo to any angle



Do not change the color of the logo



Do not reduce the opacity



Do not use outline



Do not add a drop shadow to the logo
